We have exciting news to share! Members can now view online the vast resources in Boyd Library. Previously, we had no catalog except for the one used by the librarians. Thanks to the efforts of Tony Godwin and Martha Huggins, this “upgrade” is now activated. The cost of this enhancement is only \$80 a year. Members can access the library catalog, perform a search, discover what is available by title, author, or call number, and see where the material is located on the shelves. Library news and an explanation of the layout of the library are still found on the church’s website—tmbc.org. We hope more and more members will enjoy the wonderful resources we have in our library! The library is open whenever the church is open.
