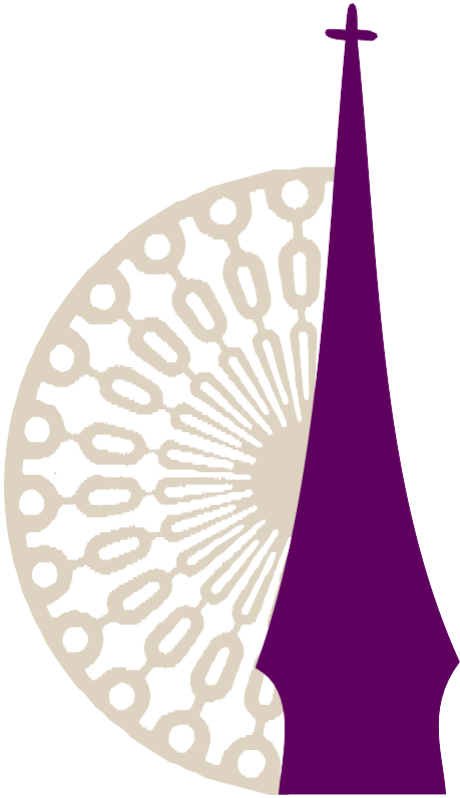

SERVICE OF DEACON ORDINATION AND INSTALLATION

Dr. Smith

Pastor: Do you trust that you are truly called by God to the ministry of deacon in this church?
