The drawstring vinyl bags contain gloves, socks, water bottle, spoons, wipes, beanie weenies, applesauce cup, cereal bar, and crackers. The children constructed 144 Stoplight Bags! Way to go!!

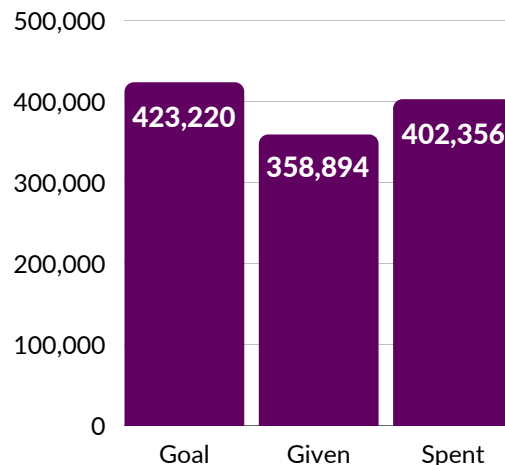
