


Youth Soup and Sandwich: November 14th

As we continue to monitor the impact of COVID-19 in our area, the team is making recommendations regarding the use of the Fellowship Hall for gatherings with food.


Food preparation and consumption is allowed in the Fellowship Hall with the following modifications:
