
April 19: Youth Go Kart Outing to Rush Hour Karts in Garner! \$20 RSVP to Tyler

May 13: End of Year Celebration for Wednesday night with the children! Cookout in the back church parking lot followed by a campout on the back lawn!


















Cake Auction Sign Up
