On **February 8**, Creative Craftin' Corner is going to make a Valentine's Day frame. There will be a \$2 charge to cover the cost of the materials.


The rest of the activities planned so far are as follows:

Christine Tripp was a long-time member of The Memorial Baptist Church. Those who were high school students in Greenville in the 1960's - 80's will remember her as an outstanding biology teacher at Rose High School. She was the tough teacher with the big heart.

Christine loved TMBC and she wanted to make sure that she could continue to support it beyond her own lifetime. 


