



Herb and Dot Paschal's Legacy

Dr. Herbert Paschal was a noted professor of History, and chair of the History Department, at East Carolina University. At TMBC he was a gifted Sunday School teacher, and he was part of the leadership team that planned, built, and moved the church from downtown Greenville to its prominent location on Greenville Boulevard in the early 1970's.

Dot Paschal loved her Sunday school class and everything about TMBC, and she will always be remembered as "a one-woman outreach team". Over the years she invited singles, couples, and families to visit the church. She was always there to welcome them and help them feel at home.



To honor their memory, and their combined 92 years of active and devoted service to the church, their children made a gift to establish the Herb and Dot Paschal Endowment Fund. This fund will provide perpetual financial support for the outreach ministries and activities of The Memorial Baptist Church.
